

**SOW-13: EXPOSURE ASSESSMENT
AND RISK CHARACTERISATION**

- 13.1 Contractor shall complete exposure assessments and risk characterisations for each substance listed by the Buyer for each of the Initial Exposure Scenarios [listed below:] {or} [developed according to SOW-12]:

- 13.3 Contractor shall solicit the following information directly from each SIEF member:
- Production volume information (manufactured and imported)
 - Percentage (%) used for each exposure scenario
 - Measured data regarding releases to the environment (all compartments)
 - Measured data regarding concentrations in the environment (all
