

**SOW-9: DATA EVALUATION & TESTING PROPOSAL**

- 9.1 *Contractor* shall perform a thorough evaluation of existing hazard data and information based on the (robust) study summaries [prepared under SOW-8] {or} [provided by the Buyer] for each substance listed by the Buyer as detailed more specifically below.
- 9.2 *Contractor* shall perform the evaluation consistent with the REACH Guidance documents titled: Guidance on Information Requirements and Chemical Safety Assessment, Chapters R.7a through R.7c and Chapters R.8 through R.11.
- 9.3 *Contractor* shall determine the completeness and quality of existing data and information for fulfilling Annexes VII through [X] of the REACH Regulation and for performing a hazard classification and risk assessment, including CMR, PBT, and vPvB assessment.
- 9.4 *Contractor* shall identify the relevant and appropriate DNEL/DMEL and DNEC values for each substance listed by the Buyer.
- 9.5 *Contractor* shall determine the hazard classification for each substance listed by the Buyer.
- 9.6 *Contractor* shall document a testing proposal that is consistent with REACH Guidance document titled: Guidance on Registration for any testing required /

- Document the proposed testing in the endpoint study record within the IUCLID data set, provided the Contractor has access to the IUCLID file, and document the justification in an appropriate comment field of the endpoint study record.
